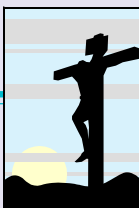

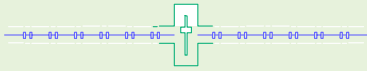
RUN THE RACE FOR JESUS!

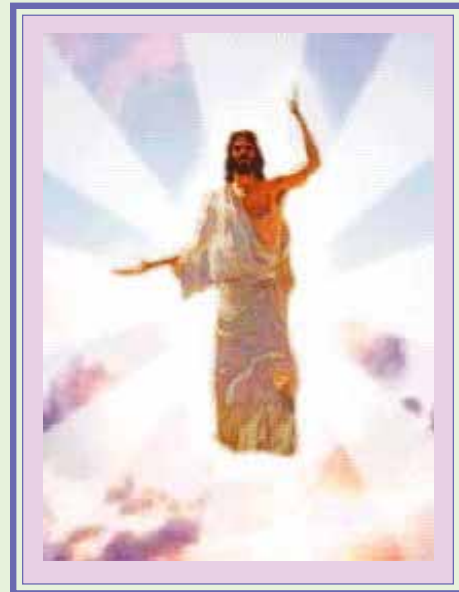

MEALS

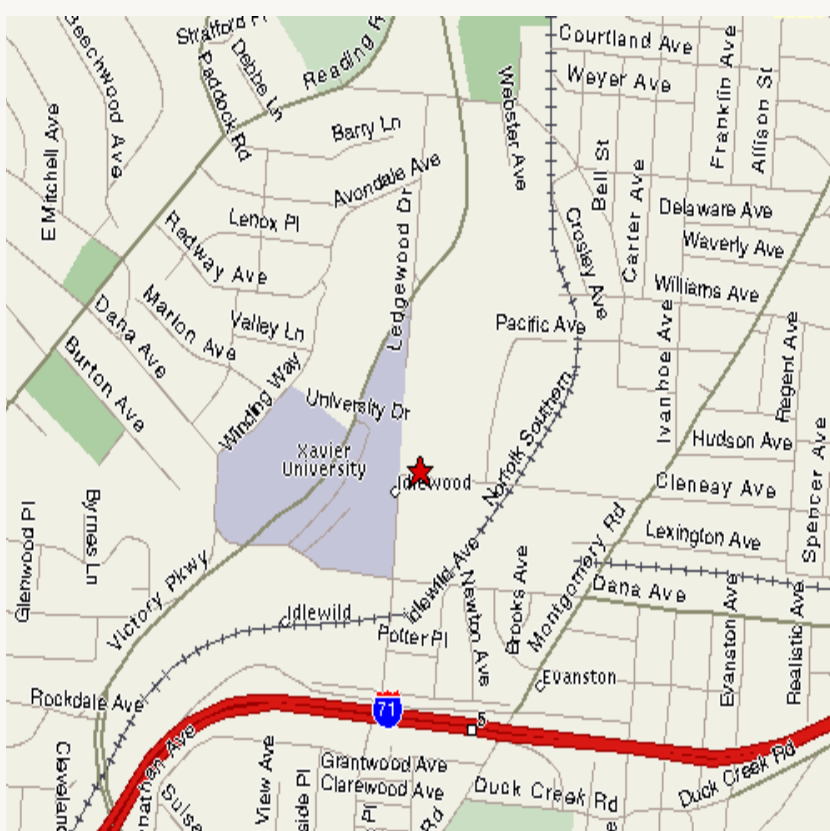

WEST: McMillan to Victory Parkway, left on Victory Parkway to Dana, right on Dana to Leggewood, left onto Leggewood.

NORTH: From I-71 take Dana exit. Go right (west) onto Dana to Leggewood, right onto Leggewood.

From I-75 take Mitchell exit, left on Mitchell and follow Xavier U. Signs to Leggewood, left onto Leggewood.

SOUTH: From I-71 take Dana exit, left on Dana (west) to Leggewood, right onto Leggewood.

Important Notice:

The North Campus lot and the Cohen Lot can be used for parking your car. Both lots can be entered from Herald Avenue. 
